

LOCAL GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE 1961
(No. 11 of 1961)

TUARAN DISTRICT COUNCIL
(PIG CONTROL) BY-LAWS 1977
(G.N.L 73 of 1977)

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 50 of the Local Government Ordinance 1961, the Tuaran District Council has made the following By-laws:

1. Title and commencement.

These by-laws may be cited as the Tuaran District Council (Pig Control) By-laws 1977 and shall come into operation on the 1st day of December 1977.

2. Interpretation.

In these by-laws —

"controlled areas" mean the areas specified in the First Schedule to these By-laws;

"prohibited areas" mean the areas specified in the Second Schedule to these By-laws.

3. Prohibition on keeping pigs.

No person shall keep any pigs in any prohibited areas within the Tuaran District Council area.

4. Permit for keeping pigs.

(1) No person shall keep any pigs in any controlled areas within the Tuaran District Council area except in accordance with a permit granted by the Council.

Application for Licence.

(2) An application for a permit shall be in writing and shall specify the locality where the applicant proposes to keep the pigs.

Grant of Licence.

(3) The Council may, in its absolute discretion, grant or refuse a permit, or grant a permit subject to such conditions as it thinks fit.

5. Prevention of nuisance.

(a) If in opinion of the Council the keeping of any pigs on any land has become or is likely to become a nuisance or injurious to health, the Council may by notice require the owner or occupier of such land within a period to be specified in the notice to do all or any of the following —

(i) to reduce the number of pigs kept thereon;

- (ii) to have the land properly fenced;
- (iii) to keep such pigs continuously penned;
- (iv) to take such other action as the Council deems necessary to minimise the likelihood of nuisance or injury to health.

(b) The owner or occupier of such land to whom a notice is given shall without unnecessary delay comply with such notice.

6. Cancellation of permit.

The Council may cancel or suspend a permit if the holder of such permit —

- (a) is convicted of any offence under these By-laws;
- (b) has failed to observe any conditions imposed by the Council in such permit.

7. Penalty.

Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of these By-laws shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a fine not exceeding two hundred ringgit.

FIRST SCHEDULE

All areas within the townships of Tuaran, Tamparuli and Tenghilan other than those zoned for commercial purpose shall be classified as controlled areas.

SECOND SCHEDULE

All areas within the townships of Tuaran, Tamparuli and Tenghilan zoned for commercial purpose shall be classified as prohibited areas.
